- Ed Mason requested the Post consider having a credit card. Rick Deiss suggested using a debit card. A motion was made by Ken Jungwirth and seconded by John Vonderloh to secure a debit card from 1st National Bank with a limit of \$1500.00. The motion carried unanimously.
- Ed Mason informed the PEC that receipts must be presented for payments.

Golf Outing:

- John Vonderloh provided a committee report on the plans for this year's golf outing on May 24th. Poster are nearly ready for printing and donations are starting to come in.
- Ken Jungwirth reported the golf course will take registrations.

Spring Dinner Banquet

- Ken Flock reported it is more difficult this year to get donations.

Legion Baseball:
