Dear comrades and friends,

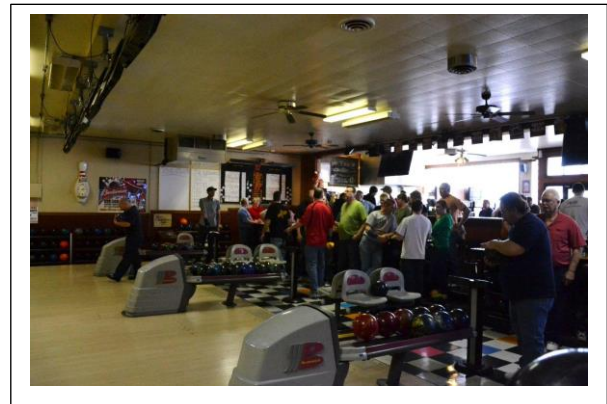

Honor Flight Comedy Show Comes to Oshkosh
